Show more confidence in new social situations. Play with one or more other children, extending and elaborating play ideas. Find solutions to conflicts and rivalries. Understand why rules are important. Talk about feelings using words like 'happy' or 'sad'

PD	Children will have opportunities to develop their gross motor skills. They will have daily access to the outdoor area with a wide range of climbing and sports equipment to develop their core strength, balance, co-ordination and agility and develop emotional well being. Repeated and varied opportunities to explore and play with small world, puzzles and art activities, practicing using small tools. Children will also be encouraged to become more independent through doing up their own zip, using a knife and fork, using the toilet independently and brushing their teeth.
